



Commanding Officer HMNZS ROTOITI



Lieutenant Regan Harris, RNZN

Lieutenant Regan Harris joined the Royal New Zealand Navy on 1 February 2011 and completed Junior Officer Common Training on 30 Jun 2011. On completion of Junior Officer Common Training Regan was promoted to Sub-Lieutenant and posted to the Maritime Warfare Training Centre to commence his Officer of the Watch (OOW) Training Courses.

During his OOW Training Regan served at sea on HMNZS TAUPO, HMNZS ROTOITI, HMNZS HAWEA, HMNZS CANTERBURY, HMNZS TE MANA and HMNZS OTAGO before gaining his Advanced Officer of the Watch Certificate on Te Kaha in 2014.

He was promoted to Lieutenant in March 2015 and posted back to the Maritime Warfare Training Centre (MWTC) where he completed the Minor War Vessel Navigating Officer's Course and the Major Fleet Unit Command Course in December 2015.

On completion of these courses Regan was posted to HMNZS ROTOITI as the Executive Officer where he remained before being posted to HMAS WATSON in Sydney to complete the Joint Warfare Application Course (JWAC) in June 2016. After completing this course he was posted to HMAS Darwin for further Warfare consolidation and training.

On returning to New Zealand in June 2017 Regan posted to the Fleet Personnel and Training Organisation where he worked as the Deputy Executive Training Officer overseeing Seamanship Combat Specialist and Dive Training. He posted back to the Maritime Warfare Training Centre and completed the Minor War Vessel Command Course in December 2017 before he assumed Command of HMNZS ROTOITI on 12 December 2017.
